REGISTRATION

All Camps, Classes, and Workshops are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

Courses do fill quickly; therefore, it is advisable to register early.

HOW TO REGISTER

Fill out all of the personal information on both sides of the Summer Tuition Worksheet.

Record number of classes desired for each age appropriate afternoon class.

Multiply number of classes by the appropriate rate to find your subtotal for class tuition.

Add all camp and workshop tuition to your class tuition to find the tuition grand total.

Record the tuition grand total at the bottom of the Summer Tuition Worksheet.

Parental signature is required to confirm total amount and total payment responsibility.

New students must enclose a non-refundable summer \$15 registration fee.

All students must enclose a non-refundable \$50.00 deposit that is applied to your tuition.

Registrations are accepted by phone, by mail, in person, or they may be dropped off in the mail drop.

SUMMER TUITION POLICY

New students must pay a non-refundable \$15 summer registration fee.

A non-refundable \$50.00 tuition deposit is required at registration for all students.

All classes, workshops, and camps must be pre-paid.

Additional classes may be added during the summer semester but must be pre-paid.

All summer tuition payments are non-refundable.

SUMMER TUITION

Afternoon classes are \$16 per hour, and \$24 per hour and a half.

Preschool classes are \$15 per hour.

Adult Cards are available for \$100 for 11 classes labeled 'Adult.'

Camp and Workshop tuition rates are explained further within the Summer brochure.

CONFIRMATION OF CLASSES, CAMPS, AND WORKSHOPS

A minimum enrollment of six students is necessary to confirm a course.

Registered students will receive a phone call only if a course is cancelled.

MISSED CLASSES

Summer tuition is non-refundable and will not be pro-rated for missed classes.

Make-ups are available for afternoon classes in summer semester classes of the same level or below.

Make-ups are not available for Camps or Workshops.

SUMMER DRESS CODE

The Summer Dress Code is flexible.

For guidance, the following is what is expected during the school year.

Creative Dance and Pre-Ballet: Solid pink leotard, pink tights, and pink ballet shoes.

No tutus or skirts. Hair styled off face and neck. Long hair must be in a ponytail or bun.

Ballet I – Ballet VII: Solid black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, and hair in a bun.

Ballet VIII – Ballet X: Any solid color leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, and hair in a bun.

Jazz: Any solid color leotard, dance shorts, or jazz pants. Solid color camisole top may be worn over leotards. Caramel-colored leather jazz shoes, slip-on or tie style.
